Ministry of Communications and Technology invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for Purchase of Goods with related Services for Designing, Development, Supply, Installation, Testing, Commissioning, and Support of the Quality of Service (QoS) Monitoring System for the support to National Communications Authority of Somalia (NCA), Federal Government of Somalia at Hamarweyne district, Po. Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding (NCB) procedures as specified in the World Bank's Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers: Procurement in Investment Financing - Goods, Works, Non-Consulting and Consulting Services dated July 1st, 2016, revised November 2017 August 2018, November 2020 and September 2023 ("Procurement Regulations").
